

Miniatures Legality

The Battletech events at Warzone 2023, are officially-recognized by the Catalyst Demo Team and must adhere to the official events miniatures rules:

- **Game Host / CDT Agent is final call on model legality.**

Model Legality:

- Only Official Models allowed:
 - Catalyst (CGL) Plastic Models
 - Ironwind Metals (IWM) Models
 - Previous Official Plastic Alpha Strike (AS) Models
 - Previous Official Metal Models (Ral Partha)
- In the case of using a unit without an official model, please contact the Game Host/CDT Agent in order to get approval of using another official model as a proxy before the event begins. If it's close, it will be approved.
- Fully 3D Printed model are not allowed (See Kitbashing Section)
- Alternative Maker models of official designs are not allowed

Kitbashing:

- Otherwise known as creating a mini or mini variant that is not currently in production by using another mini's parts or parts meant for kitbashing on a standardly produced mini. Any addition of the following parts must still follow the 80/20% rule. This means that 80% of the mini must be an official model
- **Custom things cannot represent more than 20% of the mini.** Custom things include:
 - Bits from other miniatures/makers that are in-line with the model scale/intent
 - 3D-printed bits that are inline with the model scale/intent

Dice Legality

- Only major-maker cube six-sided dice allowed. Chessex, GW, QLabs, etc
- No warped dice allowed or alternative shapes allowed
- CDT Agent has final call on dice legality
- **Cocked Dice:** A single cocked die in the pair causes a reroll of BOTH dice
- **Dice that fall off a table:** If a die falls off a table when being rolled causes a reroll of BOTH dice.
- Only bulk roll common weapon systems (aka: same To-Hit numbers and damage per hit)

Gaming Behavior Rules

- All players are expected to have read and adhere to the Guidelines listed in the 'Player Credo' shared on the Rules and Missions webpage.
